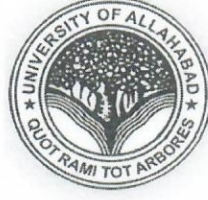

The Chairman extended a warm welcome to all members of Academic Council, Special Invitees and the newly appointed Heads of Department. Thereafter, the agenda item were taken-up.

Agenda No. 01/40 To consider the Undergraduate final year and final semester examinations of Postgraduate, in light of judgment and order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 724 of 2020 and UGC Guidelines vide Notification dated 06-07-2020, Notification of Ministry of Home Affairs dated 06-07-2020 and the Examinations Committee Resolution dated 15-06-2020 and University of Allahabad Notification No. 05/R/451/2020 dated 19-08-2020.

Resolution No.01/40 The members discussed the matter at length and resolved as under:

The University of Allahabad shall hold examinations only for final year undergraduate and final semester postgraduate students of the session 2019-20. The provisions of this resolution shall be applicable only for the session 2019-20 as a special case arising due to COVID-19 and shall not be treated as binding precedent.

A complete schedule for pending undergraduate final year examinations and postgraduate final semester examinations will be uploaded on AU website.

1. Examinations of BA, BSc and BCom Final Year Courses

- (i) The subjects/papers for which examinations have already been held in March, 2020 shall be evaluated and marks be included in the final result.
- (ii) The examinations for the pending subjects/papers will be held in online mode and the duration of the examination will be two hours and any four questions shall be attempted by students.
- (iii) The question papers will be uploaded on AU website at a given time as per the Time Table announced and the students will download the papers.
- (iv) The students shall be asked to write the examination on their own A4 size Answer Sheets bearing roll number and enrolment number on top of each page and the pages marked as 1/30, 2/30,30/30. Also, total number of pages used must be mentioned on the first page.
- (v) The students shall write the answer, scan all the written Answer Sheets and upload on the given link/email within four hours of the commencement of the examinations. Those students, who fail to do so, will be provided another chance during second examination.
- (vi) The assessment of students in the practical laboratories will be done on the basis of assignments and viva-voce. The viva-voce can also be arranged in the conferencing mode.
- (vii) A student who fails or wishes to improve his/her marks shall be allowed to appear in the second examination in all the subjects.

2. Examinations of MA, MSc, MCom, LLB, BALLB, LLM and Professional Final Semester Courses

- (i) The Internal Assessment marks of T1/Mid-Sem/T2 shall be rationalised for 40 marks. If the same has not been done so far in any case, it can be assignment based assessment.
- (ii) The examinations will be held in online mode and the duration of the examinations will be two hours and any four questions shall be attempted by students.
- (iii) The question papers will be uploaded on AU website at a given time as per the Time Table announced and the students will download the papers.
- (iv) The students shall be asked to write the examination on their own A4 size Answer Sheets bearing roll number and enrolment number on top of each page and the pages marked as 1/30, 2/30,30/30. Also, total number of pages used must be mentioned on the first page.

- (v) The students shall write the answer, scan all the written Answer Sheets and upload on the given link/email within four hours of the commencement of examination. Those students, who fail to do so, will be provided another chance during second examination.
- (vi) The assessment of students in the practical laboratories will be done on the basis of assignments and viva-voce. The viva-voce can also be arranged in the conferencing mode.
- (vii) The postgraduate dissertations, project assessment and viva-voce will be held online.
- (viii) A student who fails or wishes to improve his/her marks shall be allowed to appear in the second examinations in all the subjects.

3. Promotion of students of BA, BSc and BCom First Year Courses

- (i) The students will be promoted to the next higher class for the session 2020-21 as per UGC guidelines.
- (ii) The subjects/papers for which examinations in the session 2019-20 have already been held shall be evaluated and marks awarded after such evaluation shall be the part of the final result.
- (iii) The assessment of remaining subjects/papers/practical/viva-voce will be made on the basis of the results of BA, BSc and BCom second year examinations (to be held in future) in the respective subjects/papers/practical/viva-voce and mark sheets will be issued accordingly.
- (iv) Such students who wish to improve their BA, BSc, BCom part-I marks in those papers in which the marks have been awarded on the basis of BSc Part-II examination can appear in the subsequent examination in those papers of BA, BSc, BCom part-I whenever held in future.

4. Promotion of students of BA, BSc and BCom Second Year Courses

- (i) The students will be promoted to the next higher class for the session 2020-21 as per UGC guidelines.
- (ii) The subjects/papers for which examinations in the session 2019-20 have already been held shall be evaluated and marks awarded after such evaluation shall be the part of the final result.
- (iii) The assessment of remaining subjects/papers/practical/viva-voce will be made on the basis of the results of BA, BSc and BCom first year examinations in the respective subjects/papers/practical/viva-voce and mark sheets will be issued accordingly.
- (iv) Such students who wish to improve their BA, BSc, BCom part-II marks in those papers in which the marks have been awarded on the basis of BA, BSc, BCom Part-I examination can appear in the subsequent

examination in those papers of BA, BSc, BCom part-II whenever held in future.

5. Promotion of students of II, IV, VI and ~~XIII~~^{VIII} Semester of MA, MSc, MCom, LLB, BALLB, LLM and Professional Courses.

- (i) The students will be promoted to the next higher class for the session 2020-21 as per UGC guidelines.
 - (ii) The Internal Assessment marks of T1/Mid-Sem/T2 shall be rationalised for 40 marks. If the same has not been done so far in any case, it can be assignment based assessment.
 - (iii) The End Semester assessment for 60 marks will be done on the basis of performance in all previous semesters.
 - (iv) If a student is not satisfied with the marks obtained in even semester(s), he/she may improve his/her grade in the next available examination of that particular course in the ensuing semester.
 - (v) The students having backlog of earlier semester(s), have to clear the same as and when an opportunity appears as per CBCS rules.
6. Notwithstanding the provisions laid down, any other matter shall be resolved by the Examinations Committee as and when required.
 7. Heads/ Directors/Coordinators of Departments/Institutes /Centres were requested to submit the question papers to the Office of the Controller of Examinations and finish the moderation of the same latest by September 04, 2020.
 8. The Director, Admissions informed the house the dates of Entrance Test for admission to different UG/PG/PhD courses of the University. It was unanimously approved by the house. The Controller of Examinations was requested to take note of these dates while finalizing the examinations schedule.
